| 1 | Service | This has been an exceptional experience, nothing has been a problem in that , any upgrades or problems have been addressed by the team |
| 2 | Performance | The Fuso has all the power required for the situations we have put it to whether crossing The Simpson desert, traversing the sandy beaches of Stradbroke or cruising along the highway. |
| 3 | Tyres | The Michelin tyres are an ideal choice for the applications we have put the through, are tough and appear to be long wearing. |
| 4 | Comfort | The vehicle is well suited to offroad travel, giving excellent vision and plenty of room in the cab. The camper side is way above anything we have experienced before that is suitable for off road travel. The bed is as comfortable as our ensemble at home. |
| 5 | Cooking | The diesel stove has proved to be a winner with its cleanliness and ease of use, not to mention the fact that we don't have to worry about checking the fuel levels, as it is sourced from the vehicles tank. The back up outside with the gas stove covers us if fuel supplies are running down or we want to do extra cooking. |
| 6 | Amenities | The shower and toilet have proved a real asset in showery cool weather saving us the trips to the ablution block in the mud and wet. |
| 7 | Storage | EC1 has plenty of storage to cater for extended trips such as the 4 month trip we undertook recently, through the National Parks of Qld, NSW , Vic and S.A. Enough for up to 10 days of supplies and the ability to carry extra clothing for the cold wet days as well as the warm ones. |
| 8 | Fuel and water | Enough of each to travel a 1,000 klms or water for 10 days. |
| 9 | Security | The ability to pull up anywhere and feel safe within the unit both from the weather and thieves. |
| 10 | Solar | The battery and solar back up for lights and power, allows us to be self sufficient (not relying on powered sites) and also use our computers for downloading photos at the end of each day. We did not need to use outside power for the whole four months of our trip. |
| 11 | Wrap up | The ability to pull in to a site and be set up in 4 - 5 minutes, the same applies to getting underway in the morning. More time is required if you have the annexe and chairs out |
