Thrills and spills packed in

Four-wheel-drive track hosts challenges, displays

IT'S action-packed thrills and spills on the Isuzu D-Max Australia Four Wheel Drive Track this year.

An Isuzu company representative visited Farm Fantastic in 2009 displaying the Isuzu D-MAX range and that show was so successful for the company, it has sponsored the track in 2010 and 2011.

All-terrain vehicles, utes, caravans and four-wheel-drive vehicles will negotiate rocks, dust, sand and water obstacles on the track to the shouts and applause from the crowd in the stands.

An Isuzu spokesman said the sponsorship of the track meant that Isuzu UTE also supported the Caboolture 4WD Club and four-wheel drivers in general.

The spokesman said Farm Fantastic offered Isuzu the chance to showcase its vehicles to the public and to communicate all the features of the ute as a workhorse and family and leisure vehicle.

"The ute is a popular choice for farmers, tradies and outdoors people, who are after a top-notch utility vehicle," he said.

The Caboolture 4WD Club and its protagonist, the Moreton District Off Road Club, will continue their long rivalry for the title in the Mickey Thompson 4WD Challenge again this year.

Visitors love to watch them show off their skills, while at the same time showing the safety aspects of driving.

One of the supporters of the track is Sunshine Coast Coromal, which specialises in new caravans, pop-tops and campers.

Two familiar faces, Rachael and Cameron Whiting, will introduce their new endeavour, the Motorcycle and ATV Warehouse.

They are also sponsoring one of the prizes this year, a Kymco Maxxer 50 quad bike and gear for kids worth \$2500.

Don't forget Caboolture Motorcycles is bringing in Australia's number-one enduro rider, Jemma Wilson, who will be demonstrating her skills. Wilson has competed in a range of enduro events at state and national levels.

She was little more than 11 years old when she got her first bike and nothing has held her back since.

These shows will run for more than three hours each day and offer thrills and excitement for those interested in bikes of all sorts.

Champion rider Kurt Hatton will also be performing on the four-wheel-drive track.

The Argo ATV, Centaur UTV and Hydratrek MPAV all-season, all-terrain, amphibious, 6, 8 and tracked multi-purpose ATVs will also be there.
